- ✓ clear answer to the question
- ✓ correct grammar and sentence structure

**Essay Question**

(20 points total value)

Maximum of 4 points on each of the following:

- ✓ clear thesis statement in opening and concluding paragraphs
- ✓ well developed response to question
- ✓ correct grammar and sentence structure

Maximum of 2 points for each different reference to:

- ✓ characters
- ✓ conflicts
- ✓ themes
- ✓ plot
