

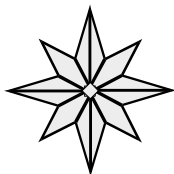

Concept mapping is a technique for visualizing the relationships among different concepts. Mnemonics – acronyms, acrostic, flash cards</p>
